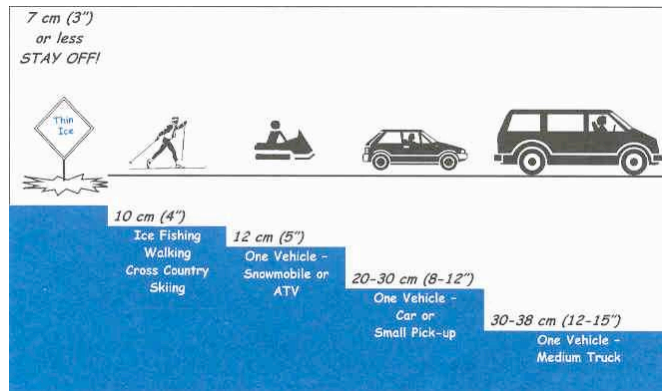

The Saskatoon Snowmobile Club is a group of enthusiastic, family oriented snowmobilers who enjoy safe, responsible snowmobiling in Central Saskatchewan.

The SSC is an active member of the Saskatchewan Snowmobile Association. Many of our members belong to the Emergency Measures Organization, assisting in search and rescue.

The SSC clubhouse is located at the old Penner School House in the North Corman Industrial Park area, between Saskatoon and Warman. It is a heated clubhouse with indoor plumbing and full kitchen facilities including a BBQ. GPS: N 52.24600 Latitude, W 106.11666 Longitude.

The Saskatoon Snowmobile Club owns and operates a BR 400 Trail Groomer complete with at 12 ft. Mogul Master drag. A trail, complete with signs, runs from the north Shell station in Saskatoon through the communities of Warman, Hague, Rosthern and Duck Lake, enjoying a warm up shelter along the way, near Hague. This effectively allows snowmobilers to ride from Saskatoon on a safe, smooth trail and link up with the extensive snowmobile trail network already existing in the Forest Fringe, and the Trans Canada Snowmobile Trail.

General meetings are held at the clubhouse during the winter season, along with many social events throughout the year. Visitors are always welcome.
